

Sports Premium Funding 2016-2017

“Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of P.E and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how to do this.”

Schools with 17 or more eligible pupils receive £8,000 and an additional payment of £5 per pupil.

Our allocation for 2016-2017 is £8810

Objectives for Sports Premium Funding:

At Abbey Park Primary Academy we strive to deliver a rich and varied PE curriculum and we are committed to engage more pupils in extra-curricular sporting activities and events. We will ensure that:

- all children benefit regardless of sporting ability
- children are given the opportunity to compete in competition with other cluster schools
- staff have access to training opportunities and to work alongside qualified coaches to continue professional development
- some activities may be subsidised so that pupils do not miss out due to financial constraints

Using the funding:

- Employ a member of staff to organise multi-skills activities at lunchtime and after school on a daily basis.
- Provide CPD for our teachers and sports apprentice through working with specialist coaches.
- Employ specialist PE teachers to work alongside teachers to increase knowledge and confidence in PE.
- Provide training for teachers and assistants to improve playground games
- To create and maintain links to feeder High Schools and continue to participate in local competitions and events with cluster schools.
- To enable and encourage children to participate in out of school clubs by working closely with local teams/clubs
- To continue to buy new sports equipment when needed to allow children to fulfil their potential across a wide range of sports

How the funding will be spent:

£5,500 – provision: a range of after school clubs, peer teaching, teachers supported with delivering PE curriculum objectives by outstanding sports apprentice

£1,000 – Sports competition membership

£626 – Sports equipment (2xTable-Tennis tables to improve weekly Enrichment programme)

£1,000 – Cricket and Rugby specialist coaching (working alongside members of staff creating a strong link with the local community)

£250 – Sports equipment (Outdoor footballs, tennis balls, sponge balls, multi-coloured bibs)
