












The new academic year 2022-23

The academic year for 2022-23 begins for pupils on Monday 5th September. There will be a staggered start which is outlined below:

<u>Year7</u> Pupils are required in school on Monday 5th September by 8.40am ready for an 8.45 start. Pupils will have two sessions with their tutor and normal lessons will begin Lesson 3 of the day.

<u>Years 8, 9, 10, 11</u> are required in school on Monday 5th September ready for a 10.15am start. Pupils will have a tutor session and normal lessons will begin Lesson 3 of the day.

Attendance

Attendance at school is essential for your child's academic and social development and therefore it is our expectation that pupils attend school, unless there is a valid reason for absence. This is explained in our attendance policy which can be found on the school website. Pupils should aim for at least 97% attendance. An attendance of 90% is not good and means a child will have missed 4 whole school weeks. Over 5 years this would mean a child would miss half a school year. Attendance below 90% is considered persistent absence and will mean close monitoring by the pastoral team, possible involvement of the Education Welfare Officer and possible prosecution.

Uniform

Having a high standard of personal appearance is of the utmost importance at Abbey Park and this also goes for PE Kit. In September we will expect all pupils to be in full uniform. If a pupil arrives to school in incorrect uniform this will be managed during registration and may mean parents are contacted to remedy the situation and ensure their child is in correct uniform for the day. The list of uniform expectations, including for PE, are outlined below for your reference.

- Black Blazer with Abbey Park School Logo
- Tie black with gold stripes
- Optional black v-neck jumper with Abbey Park School Logo
- White Shirt
- Black trousers/appropriate knee-length black skirt/black tailored shorts
- Black shoes (no trainers or daps)
















We expect all pupils to have the following compulsory items to be able to participate in PE lesson:

GIRLS

- APS Short sleeve training top
- APS Training short or Skort
- APS Full zip or half zip training top
- APS Socks

BOYS

- APS short training sleeve training top
- APS Training shorts
- APS Pro tech reversible rugby shirt
- APS socks

Also long hair must be tied back and all Jewellery removed for health and safety reasons. In addition to the compulsory list you may wish to also purchase some of the optional items.
